### K-Group Discussion Questions

1. What was the main problem with the church at Sardis? How was this problem different from what the other churches faced? Do you think the Sardis problem is a big problem for the church in America? How so?
2. How are you sometimes tempted to rely on your past reputation when the present reality is a bit shaky?
3. The important question seems to be who gets to decide what is real, true and right— God or the world? What do you think about this question?
4. The Bible clearly teaches that friendship with the world is not a good thing (e.g., James 1:27; 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17; John 15:19; 17:14-17; Romans 12:1-2). When we find ourselves too friendly with the world, Jesus advises five things in Rev. 3:2-3. How might these help us to love and listen to God more than the world?
5. What are some specific ways we can help each other be aware of the pull of the world and let God be the main voice in our lives?
6. How do Jesus' words in Rev. 3:4-6 encourage you?
